This includes but is not limited to personal safety, process safety, occupational health and industrial hygiene in coordination with the site medic, and emergency response.

Main Tasks

Process Safety

- Participate in relevant risk assessments such as MoC and ORA.
- Site focal point for implementation and upkeep of IOGP PSF.

Personal Safety

 SME or conduit for information on key risk areas such as W@H, CSE, Hot Work, PPE etc. and focal point for IOGP LSR

Safety Leadership



- Display clear and positive safety leadership behaviours, balancing support and respectful challenge as required.
- Monitor safety leadership on site and support continuous improvement through coaching or other means.
- Coach site leaders on effective delivery of Team Safety Meetings, pre shift briefs, etc.

Emergency Response

- Prepare and deliver a range of scenarios to test all aspects of offshore ER provision and capability. **Assurance**
 - Manage the site level assurance activities in coordination with the OIM to assure regulatory expectations are met and that current risk areas are being tested.
 - Analyse collected data, identify and communicate trends. Propose corrective action plans to address issues.

Occ Health and Industrial Hygiene

- Fulfil the role of site RPS
- Site Asbestos focal point (Duty to Manage).
- Engagement and support of site Medic in discharge of their responsibilities.

Incident Investigations

- Assist OIM in determining requirements for and appropriate level of investigation and assist with QC of investigation prior to close out.
- Lead and participate in investigations.

Environment

• Act as conduit for information on key PLANC commitments. Test and verify compliance and highlight areas of potential risk.

• Submit PON1/2, OIR13 etc. in partnership with OIM. Support available from ECA as required.

Quality

• Identify actual or potential Quality issues and interface with onshore QA to resolve.

Misc

- Support the ESR's and promote workforce engagement.
- Support preparation for and offshore delivery of regulatory inspections.
- Attend asset specific meetings such as: CoW, Ops Integrity, Asset Integrity, Cumulative Risk.
- As required, support onshore preparation for TAR's participate in activities such as Assurance Reviews, HAZOP, Safety Studies etc.
